

Driving Directions from Eastern US to 34 private ranch cabin:

Get to Artesia or Roswell depending upon which direction you are driving from.

**From Artesia** take 82 towards Mayhill and Cloudcroft. Just AFTER Mayhill you will turn left onto HWY 130. You will follow HWY 130 until you see a left turn onto HWY 24 (sign here for Weed and Pinon) turn left here and follow HWY 24. (Follow rest of directions below)

**From Roswell**, NM you will want to take NM hwy 285 south towards Artesia, NM.

\*note: before you depart get gas, snacks everything you need that's about it for gas and stores until you return to Roswell!! There is a small gas station in Pinon if you forget, or we have emergency fuel at the main ranch house.

South of Roswell, NM you will want to keep an eye out for signs for the prison. Shortly after the prison you will take a right onto HWY 13. This is a little shortcut to HWY 82. You will want to head for Mayhill/Pinon/Cloudcroft on 13. You will intersect with HWY 82 and turn right (towards Cloudcroft and Mayhill).

Take HWY 82 to HWY 24. Turn left here on 24 (well before Mayhill). (Rio Penasco School is on your left just PAST the turn onto HWY 24 if you see the school turn around).

**Directions for both Roswell and Artesia**

Take HWY 24 into the "town" of Pinon, NM (small store, 4 houses, community center and a post office)

In Pinon take a left (only left) onto Owen Prather Road right across from the community center (if you miss this turn you will pass the post office on your left). This road is paved. Follow Owen Prather road out into the country until the first major right turn, really more of a fork and it's also RIGHT WHERE the pavement ends.

You will see a huge arrow made of metal here that says Timberon and points to a right turn. Turn here onto Surveyors Canyon Road. You are going to be on this road about 4 miles.

On Surveyors Canyon Road you are going to cross a cattle guard very quickly (#1) after the turn off of Owen Prather RD.

When you cross the next cattle guard (#2) you are now on our ranch (orange POSTED signs). Keep going, at about 4 miles you will see a small road that turns off to the right towards a small gray cabin, this is home! If you hit a 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> cattle guard you missed us!

If you arrive and no one is home the door should be open. Make yourself at home and move in. Get your gear in the room with the 2 sets of bunk beds (whatever bed you want take), we should be right back we may have needed gas, groceries or are scouting. We will always try and leave you a note!

**NOTE:** Roswell is about the END of cell service, make your calls here. This is about it for Gas stations, snacks, phone, people, everything before camp.

From Roswell to camp is about 2-2.5 hours ish going slow, please check the time if you are in Roswell before 11 stop have lunch. Please try and not get into camps before 1-2pm we want to be ready for you!!

\*\*\*once at the cabin you can utilize the Wi-Fi calling on your phone. Some phones are unable to do this, but can use Facebook messenger or WhatsApp. If you are planning on using either of these, you will want to download them before you arrive. The Wi-Fi password is written on the back of the router (next to the fireplace) \*\*\*
